HEAT PUMP SAVINGS

In December 2024, the heat pumps needed 1280kWh energy to heat the church. In December 2023 the Drugasar heaters needed 11870kWh energy, all from fossil fuel. The heat pumps therefore saved 90% of the energy used, and all of the CO2 emissions
